



Pedestrian Snow Plough

The PSP bi-directional pedestrian snow plough makes clearing driveways, paths, and pavements simple and efficient. It cuts effort in half compared to shovelling by utilising bodyweight, arms, and legs.

Robust steel blade with angled design allows snow to slide off easily. Flip the handle to change direction instantly.
